

How to become a NEF Board member:

- Contribute to Board diversity (ethnicity, gender, profession, education).
- Develop contacts with an extensive network of people interested in preserving quality public education in NISD.
- Donate time, energy, expertise, and sometimes funds. No fees required to join.
- Volunteer prior to serving on the Board.
- Board members are not required to live in NISD or have children in NISD.

What is expected of NEF Board members:

- Don't miss more than three meetings.
- Serve a three-year term.
- Serve on a minimum of one committee at all times during service.
- Grow operating budget and endowment annually.



NEF Designated Funds and Grants

Reminding employees they do not have to be teachers to apply for grants, NEF seeks funds from all NISD faculty and staff during its Annual Giving Campaign and, in turn, awards grants throughout the school year.

Grants are read and scored by a committee of NEF Board members, NISD administrators, and community and business volunteers. Training for how to apply for and win a NEF grant is provided by the NISD Grants & Recognitions Department.

In addition, NISD is able to use NEF's tax-exempt status to apply for other grants that are not open to public school districts without NEF's 501 c-3 authority. Designated or restricted donations to NEF are designed to be exclusively donor-driven. In each, IRS rules limit the use of funds to the specific goals of the donor.

The Foundation has 30 designated funds. NEF applies interest earned to funds of \$10,000 or more commensurate with NEF's endowment performance.




Designated Funds to Beneficial Programs in 2021-2022*




