

Connally Student Dress Code

- · Clothing should cover chests, midriffs, backs and undergarments.
- Clothing must have an over the shoulder strap at least the width of an ID or credit card.
- Clothing, accessories, or personal grooming that depicts sexual acts, nudity, gangs, tobacco, alcohol
 products, drugs, weapons or violence are not permitted.













- Bottoms should cover all skin above fingertips*
 - *While standing or walking with hands naturally by side, bottoms must not be shorter than the longest finger.
- Bottoms must be worn at the waist, no loose fitting or oversized pants permitted.













- For safety purposes, trench-style coats, chains, collars, or spiked jewelry are not permitted. All jewelry must be school appropriate.
- Headwear, including hoods, must not be worn inside the building (not to include religious headwear).
- Body art in any form to include tattoos, writing on skin, and distracting or inappropriate stickers is not permitted.
- Backpacks, duffle bags, and tote bags must be clear or mesh











*Because fads in dress and grooming are subject to sudden and sometimes radical change, modifications to the dress code may be announced, implemented, and enforced during the course of the academic school year. Final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rest with the principal or his/her designee.
