HB 3 Annual Report

HB 3 passed in 2019 requires districts to adopt **five-year goals** with annual targets in three key areas: **early childhood literacy, early childhood math, as well as college, career, and military readiness.**

Progress of the District toward Meeting the Board-adopted HB 3 Goals in:

- Grade 3 Reading, Grade 3 Mathematics, and CCMR Indicators

Goals were developed by:

- Reviewing multiple years of data to determine trends
- Continued improvement at an incremental pace
- Designing annual targets with a 1% increase each year at the Meets level

GOAL:

By the end of SY 2029-30, the percentage of students achieving Meets on 3rd grade STAAR READING will increase to 57%.

Proposed HB 3 Goals for 2029-2030

- By the end of SY **2029-30**, the percentage of students achieving Meets on 3rd grade STAAR reading will increase to **57%**.
- By the end of SY **2029-30**, the percentage of students achieving Meets on 3rd grade STAAR mathematics will increase to **53%**.
- By the end of SY **2029-30**, the percentage of students achieving CCMR will increase to **70%**.
