ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS

Students may be exempt from their Spring Semester Exams if they meet the following criteria:

1. The student must have 3 or fewer absences for the second semester excluding school business (ESB) absences in the exempted course.
2. The student's semester average is **80** or higher.
3. The student's conduct grade in that class is "S" or better.
4. The student must attend during the scheduled exam time.

In compliance with **House Bill 1481**, all students must power off their cell phones and store all electronic devices—including phones, smartwatches, earbuds, tablets, and similar items—in their backpacks or in a designated classroom location.

This policy is in effect **from the first bell to the last bell**, including passing periods and lunchtime. Students in violation of this State law could be subject to disciplinary consequences.

Students are given the time in class to research careers, complete their college applications, apply for financial aid and scholarships as part of the class.
