MORNING ROUTINE – HALL WAITING AREAS

- At 8:00 all students report to waiting areas
- Can attend tutoring on teacher tutoring days or with a pass
- No food or drinks in waiting area – You will have to throw items away
- Once you're seated, stay seated
- Ask for permission to get up or use restroom
- Cannot eat breakfast once you are in your waiting area
- Act appropriately – check language, behavior, noise level



MORNING ROUTINE - CAFETERIA

- Breakfast lines open at 7:40
- If you are in the cafeteria, you must be eating – not a place to hang out or wait for friends
- Clean up after yourselves –
- No food allowed outside the cafeteria
- Put unopened items in the share cart
- Once you leave cafeteria – cannot come back



CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to stay in their seats. No moving seats.

Hoods need to be removed.

No backpacks are allowed in the lunch lines. Backpacks must be behind your chair.

Students need to raise their hands to get water or use the restroom.

Students **MUST** have a pass to use the restroom.

No loud talking, screaming, making messes, throwing food, or sharing food allowed.



DRESS CODE

- No dress code, but must follow NISD rules.
- No holes or rips in jeans, even with Patches.



DRESS CODE

- No Sagging

 - Pants should be at waist line
 - Should not be able to see underpants



DRESS CODE

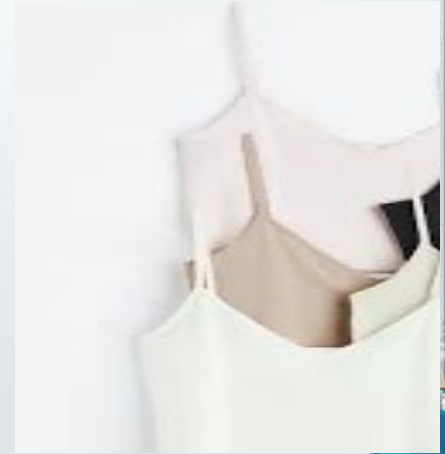
- No Sagging – Why

DRESS CODE

- Ladies – No low cut shirts. Students should be wearing either black t shirts or polo shirts. No cleavage.
- Shorts/Skirts must be 3 inches Above the knee.
- Must wear a top under hoodies.

AWAY FOR A DAY

- Technology is allowed before and after school.
 - Starting at 1st–8th periods, phones must be turned off and in backpacks—not pockets. This includes airpods and watches. This is state law.
- Phones may be collected after 1 warning.



TARDIES

- 5 min. passing period – get to class ON TIME!
- Use time wisely (restroom, water)
- Don't linger in the halls or corridors
- If next class in same building – stay in that building.
- Students can lose passing periods or receive Dhall.





HALLWAY BEHAVIOR

- No Mischief / Horseplay
- Do not hang out in the restroom
- Walk and talk – don't block traffic areas
- Keep your hands to yourself
- Be respectful – use appropriate language, accept redirection



PASSING PERIODS – 5 MINUTES

Students are allowed to use this time to go to the restroom or get water.

Students are not to vandalize restrooms– this can result in criminal mischief charges.

Students can lose their passing periods if they can't comply with expectations.



BUS BEHAVIOR

- + Safety is always first
- + It's a privilege not a right
- + Follow the bus driver's instructions. Stay in your seat.
- + Bus Riders are the only students allowed in the bus loop.
