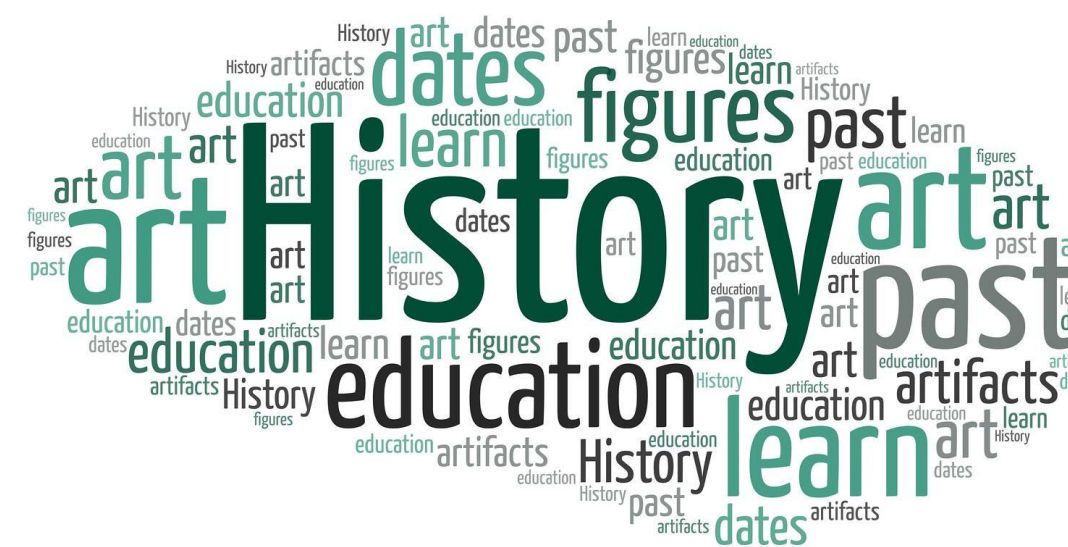

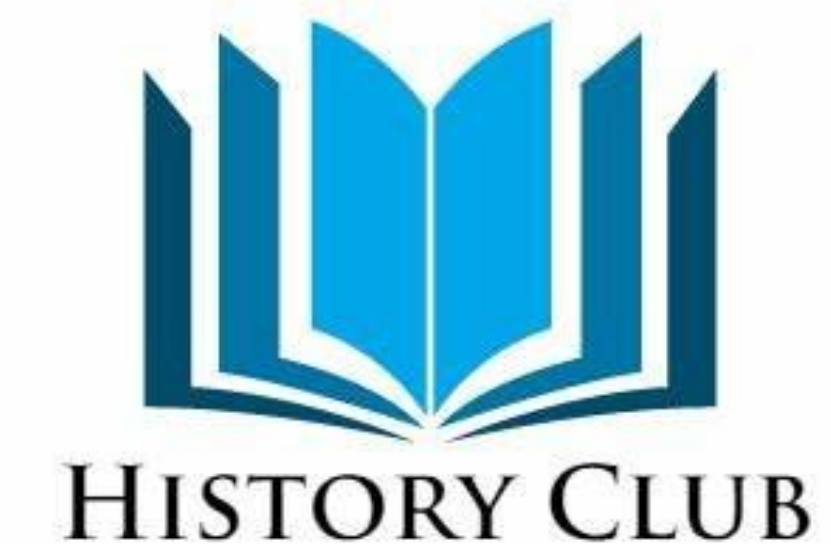


# Join Luna's National History Club!

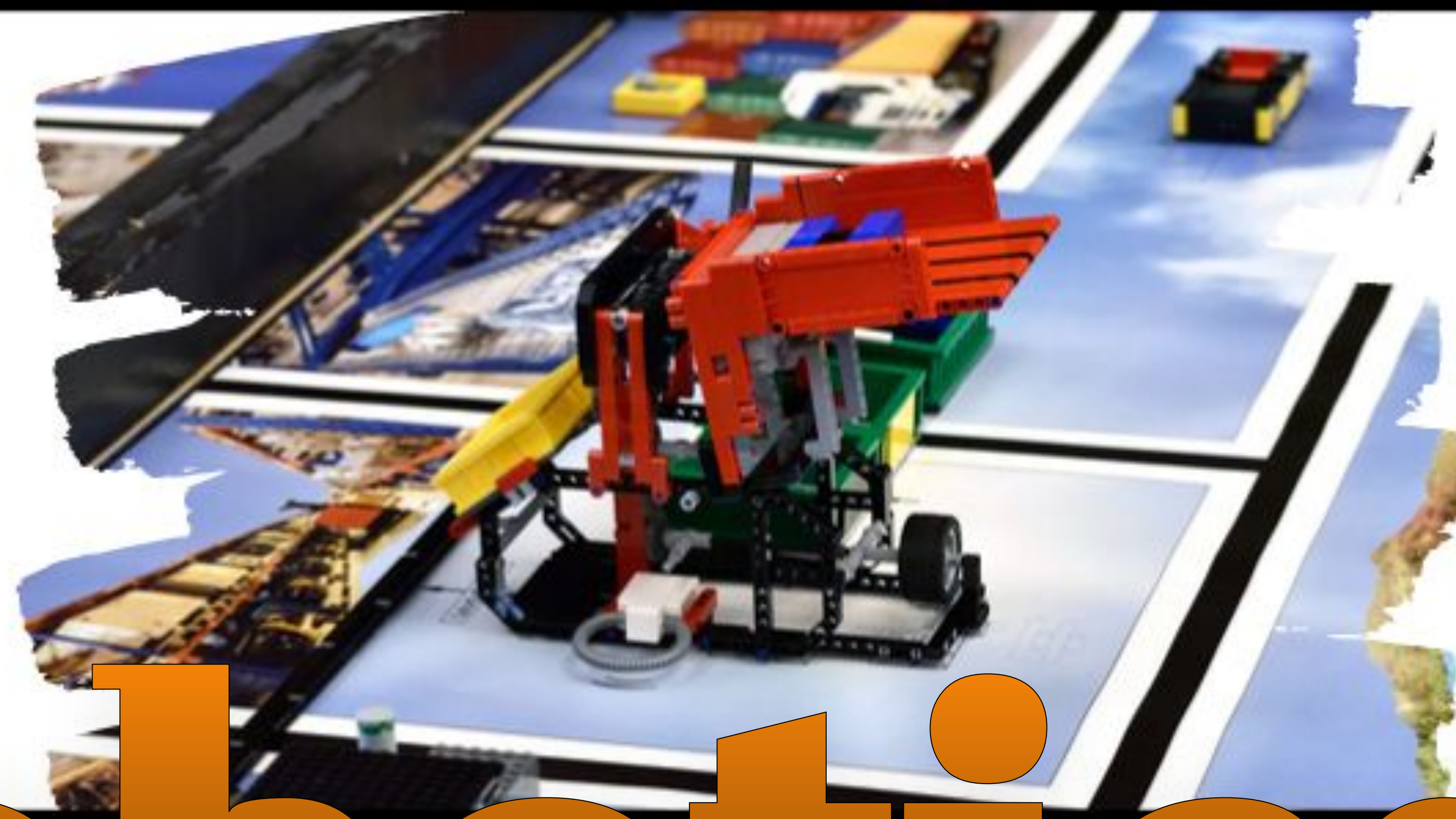

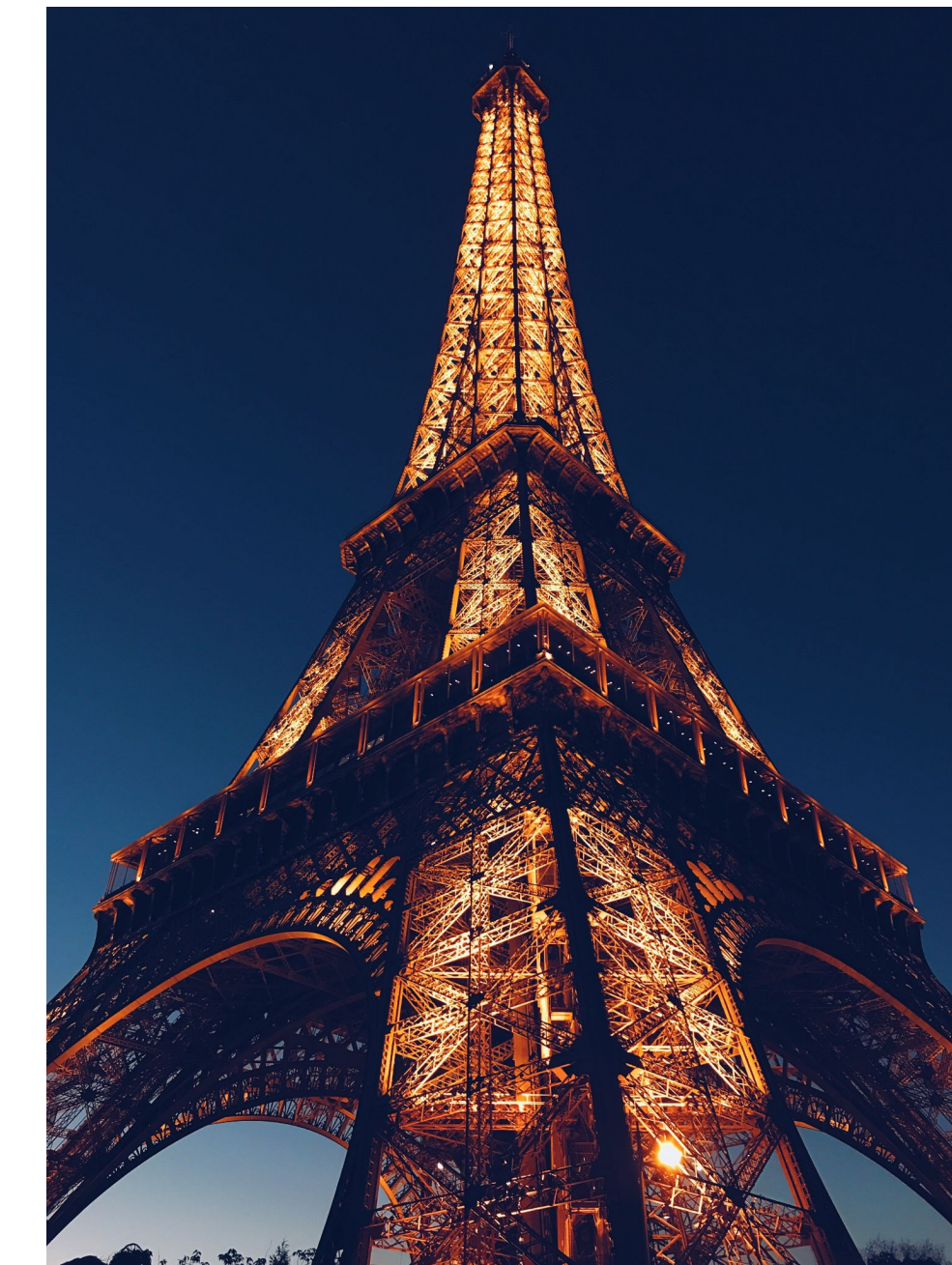
# Luna Middle School is **TRAVEL BOUND!**

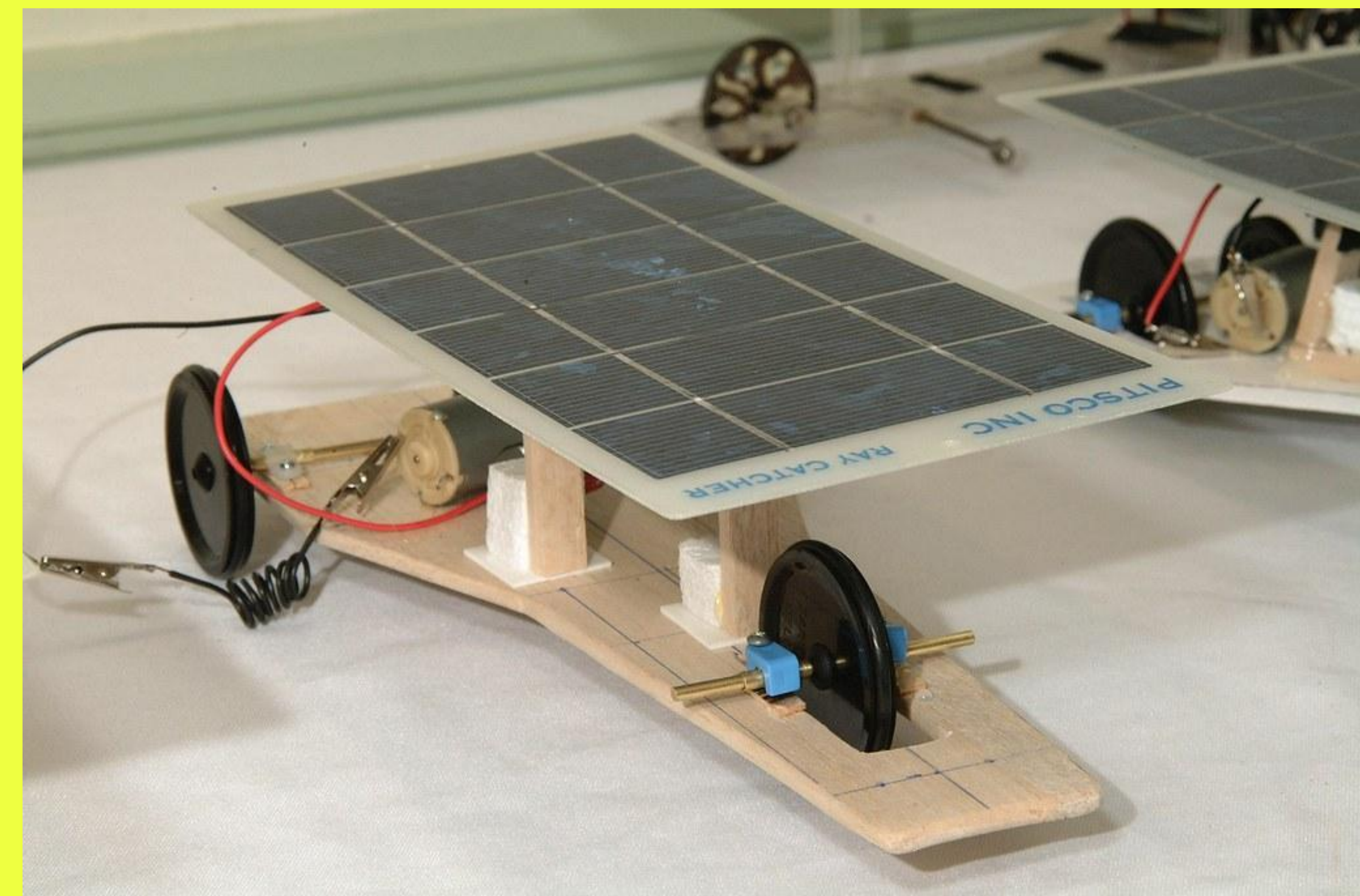

# NJHS *QUALIFICATIONS*

**ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BEING A PART OF NJHS? THERE ARE A FEW THINGS YOU HAVE TO KNOW TO BE CONSIDERED AS A CANDIDATE.**

- To be eligible for membership, the candidate must be a seventh or eighth-grader.
- Students must have been in attendance at Gregory Luna Middle School the entire fall semester of the year for which they are being considered.
- Candidates must have a cumulative scholastic average of 90 for the fall semester of the current school year. There should be no grades below 70 for any grading period. Students in core High School courses will have five points added. Students must exhibit exemplary character, outstanding citizenship, capable leadership, and devoted service.
